NOHVCC "Great Trails" Handbook

The National Off-Highway Vehicle Conservation Council (NOHVCC) has published an excellent 300-page book on how to manage, plan, design, engineer, build, and maintain a system of OHV and/or non-motorized trails.

This book will become the "Bible" for public and private land managers



and all trail user groups. Learn about what makes a trail user

friendly, sustainable, and have that "WOW" factor. This manual was written for any land management office, state or regional associations,



or clubs that have an interest in public use trails. It is incredible the amount of detail that went into writing this. This guidebook won the 2016 Education and Communication Annual Achievement Award from the Coalition for Recreational Trails.

Off-Highway Vehicle Registrations

Most of us know that Off-highway

vehicles must be registered with Colorado Parks and Wildlife. Off-highway vehicles (OHVs) include motorcycles, dirt bikes, three-wheelers, ATVs, and dune buggies that are operated on public land or trails in Colorado.

The BIG CHANGE is that For Non-Residents and Resident Plated

Vehicles: OHV Permits for non-residents and resident plated vehicles (off road + street legal vehicles) are avail-

able for purchase online. Please allow 14 days for your order to arrive in the mail.

OHV permits are also available at retail locations selling hunting and fishing licenses.

To purchase a permit in-person upon arrival in Colorado, please see the license agent list to find a retail location near you.


